



“Spellbinder”

*36% Cabernet Sauvignon, 33% Cabernet Franc, 20% Merlot,
5% Sangiovese, 4% Syrah, 2% Petit Verdot
Columbia Valley*

The 2010 Spellbinder was aged in older French oak barrels for 11 months. The cooler growing season allowed for extended hang time for the fruit, allowing for full flavor development while retaining the natural acids that make this such a terrific food wine. Loaded with black and red fruits, this wine has supple tannins and it should age for awhile, but it drinks so well right now, who can wait?
