AVA; and it is not only rare, it's exhilarating! The explosive aromatics and flavors of strawberries, cigar box, underbrush, smoke, pomegranates, and fresh herbs leap from the glass, and the vivid, lush red fruit and accompanying minerality carry this rare gem through to a long, dusty finish. Another simply magical wine from the team at Sleight of Hand! Only 45 cases were produced, so if you are holding this bottle, don't let it go.

“Already in bottle, the 2011 Grenache Upland Vineyard is 100% Grenache that comes from the tiny Snipes Mountain AVA, which is one of the warmest terroirs in the state. Harvested on November 3 and aged all in neutral oak for 14 months, it offers up a light ruby color to go with perfumed cherry, flowers, strawberry and white pepper-like aromas and flavors. Pinot Noir-like in its perfume and texture, this medium-bodied 2011 has an elegant, yet rich mouthfeel, loads of fruit and a seamless finish. Already complex and evolved, it will drink nicely for 4-6 years. Drink now-2017.”
