## “Funkadelic Syrah”

*100% Syrah  
Walla Walla Valley*

The 2011 Funkadelic Syrah is a wine with a true sense of place. It is undeniably from “The Rocks,” located in the Walla Walla Valley AVA. From the intensely dark purple color, to the animalistic aromas and flavors of rare meat, black licorice, and spicy plums, there is no mistaking this wine's terroir. All of this is complimented by the wine's amazing body and texture—rich on the entry but beautifully balanced by the bright acids from the cool 2011 vintage. This wine underwent native fermentation with 33% whole cluster. It spent 14 months in 100% neutral French oak barrels, and was sur-lie aged the entire time.
