"The Sorceress" 60% Grenache/40% Syrah

The 2015 Sorceress is a blend of 60% Grenache from Upland Vineyard in the Snipes Mountain AVA, and 40% Syrah from Les Collines Vineyard in the Walla Walla AVA. This wine was 50% whole cluster, foot-stomped and 100% native fermented before being aged in all French oak, of which 80% were neutral barrels and the balance were new. It presents with classic Greance notes of garrigue, allspice, tobacco, strawberries, and dark cherries; all of which is backed up by the classic Les Collines minerality and fresh acidity, and dark plum and olive notes. The long, lingering finish shows refined tannins and brightness. This wine is age-worthy and will continue to develop over the next decade.
