





"This is the second consecutive win in this category for Trey Busch's Renegade Wine Company, based in the Walla Walla Valley, and it is especially impressive, given it is among the least expensive roses considered in the category. It's 80 percent Syrah; the remainder is Cinsault, Counoise and Grenache. The bone-dry fruit combines cherry and melon, with complexities ranging from mineral notes to green notes (watermelon rind, kiwi.)"

PAIRS WITH: A perfectly roasted chicken, with butter under the skin and caramelized lemons on top.
